Despite being stuck alone during the several months when COVID started, these little guys always kept me company, and helped me get out of bed to feed them and play with them. I'm grateful to them for that.

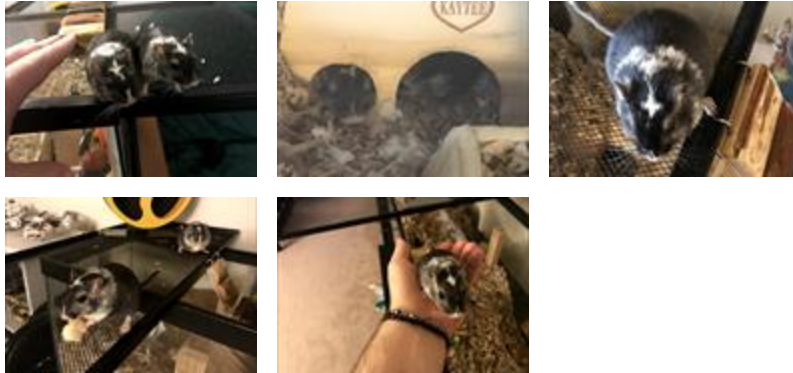
