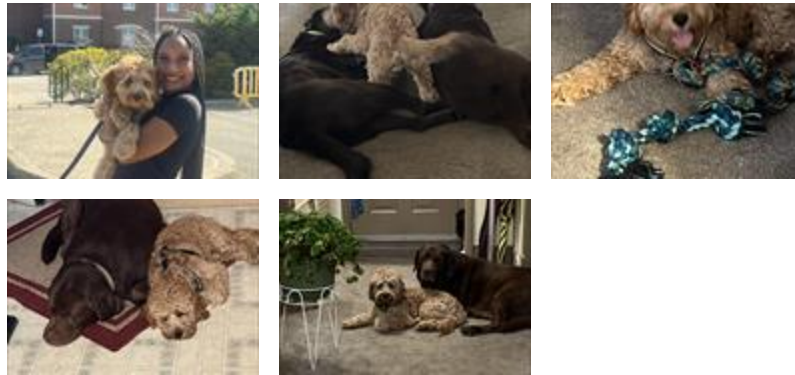

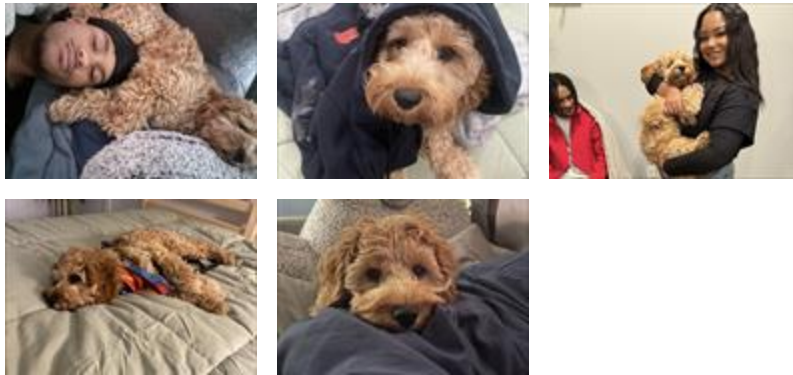
“ Henny Cash, We are so heartbroken ,were going to miss you so much,from your mother bringing you down

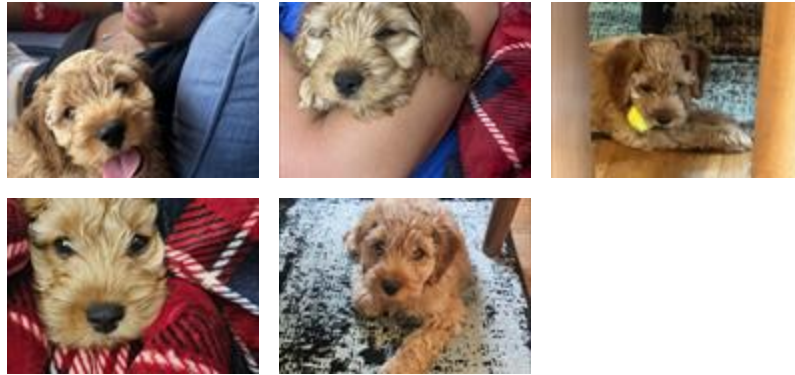

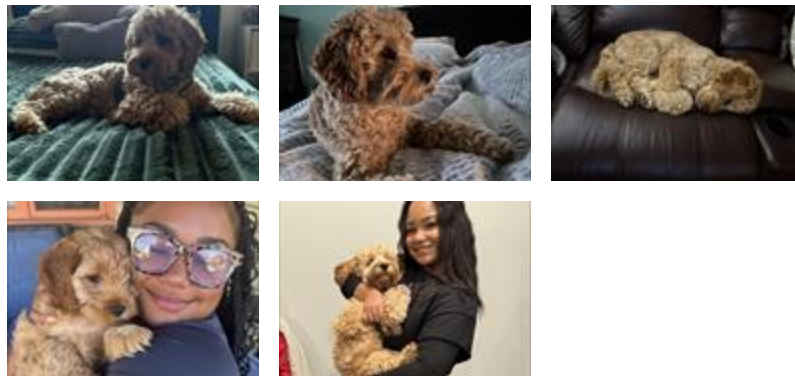
