She was great at keeping secrets. She didn't tell anyone when her human sister Gabby would sneak her an extra bowl of food, or even when her human

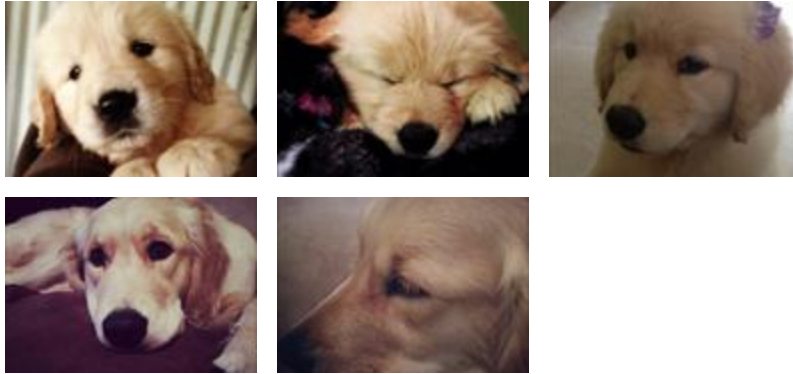

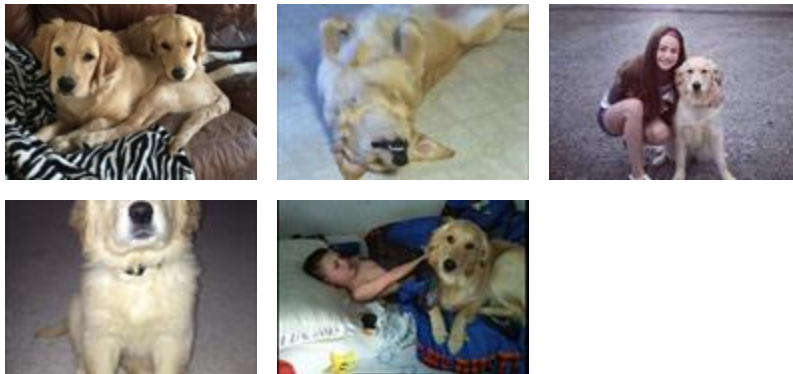
