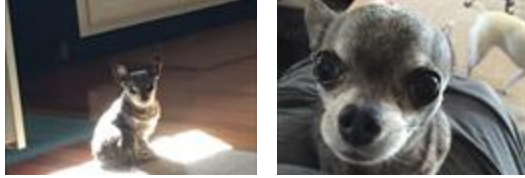

She'd coaxed him out from under the neighbor's car, plying him with better food than he'd had in a long time (if he'd even had any), and the reassuring voice and care that only she can give. He was skittish and in need of some healing, but obviously full of life, love, and personality, and I think we all realized that day that our pack had just grown another couple of pounds. We took him to the vet for evaluation and treatment, and were told the little guy was approximately ten years old. We never knew exactly what had happened to him, where he came from, or why he chose our door that day, but we're happy he did.

The thought occurred that Mick probably had quite the story to tell, but we never needed to hear it - we just needed him, like he needed us. It didn't take Mick long to bounce back and stake his place in our home and our hearts, and we were lucky to have another five years of laughs and fun with that miniature firebrand.
