"Momma Morry" outlived a lot of her offspring and was a spry, spunky, skinny and always healthy 8 pound roommate of many animals from the past. In November, 2023 she had an operation that showed the presence of cancer. Unfortunately that caught up with her, along with diabetes, and she took a fast downturn in December 2024. Losing weight, along with her sight and hearing, she was still able to get around the house. She slept peacefully with me on her last night, and sadly lost her ability to walk the next morning when, just before sunrise, her mommy and I were able to hold her as she crossed that celebrated Bridge where every one of our past pets will be waiting to be released when it's our turn to bond with them once again.
